

# Revise Checklist for a Conclusion Paragraph



- The information is accurate; I have not exaggerated.
- All sentences explain or describe the essay's main idea.
- The paragraph is cohesive; each idea ties with the next.
- My artistic writing / figurative language matches the essay's tone and is not cliché.
- I have a variety of sentence types:  
*complex, compound, a sentence that begins with a participial phrase, a sentence that ends with a participial phrase, etc.*
- I have read the conclusion paragraph ALoud and have sought my teacher's advice regarding how to correct any awkward wording.
- I have checked the subject/verb agreement within each sentence.
- I have checked the verb tense of each sentence.
- I have included transitions or transitional phrases whenever needed:  
*cause & effect, contrast, bridge transition, etc.*
- I have included powerful verbs.
- I have included vocabulary words.
